What the SDBGarden provides:

- Free entry for two sales people per booth for the day, check-in and SDBG badge required
- 10' X 10' pop-up tent, roof only, placed just beyond the Conservatory
- Six 10' X 10' white tents will be available each Fri-Sun
- You are welcome to bring your own fabric for additional shade
- Two 6' X 30" plastic tables and 2 chairs
- Electrical cord
- Wi-Fi
- Trashcan

Load-in of your plant material and set-up begins at 8:00 AM

Load-in is through the delivery driveway on the West side of the Conservatory, some wagons will be available.

Tear down begins 4pm to be completed by 5pm. Limited onsite storage for plants available.

Friday, August 13, is the VIP opening event and we will not have the market open. Sept 11 & 12 there will be no market.

Vendor tents can be reserved for individual days or for the whole weekend. Smaller scale sellers are able to share a tent.

The market is open to the public from 9AM until 5PM, accessible to Garden visitors with admission. Please bring boxes or bags for your customers, and label and price each plant.

Garden visitors can buy plants and leave them with vendor for later pick up, please have a way to mark such plants.

The cost of selling at the exhibit will be an honor system of 10% of sales daily. The 10% is payable to the San Diego Botanic Garden in cash or check and will be handled by the admissions staff at the entry.
